- **THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION** - Tuesdays from 5-5:45 p.m.

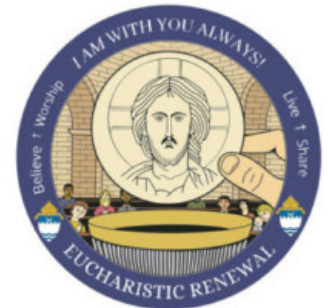


## NEW AND UPCOMING NEWS AT ST. JOSEPH

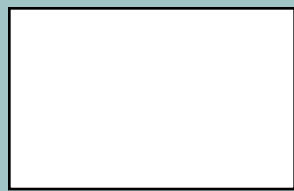

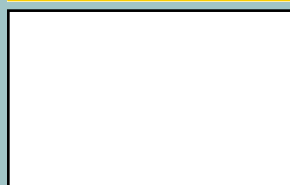
